My dear Aunt:

As we told you, we plan to go to Europe for three or four months, leaving about the middle of June, and I judge you are reasonably acquainted with such addresses as there are available to you of the Hortons and the branch of the Watkin family which used to be at Leighton-Buzzard. I spent some time, you will remember, with all of these branches, (in 1907) as well as with Mrs. Mann at Northampton, but the war, I judge, has completely broken up the Horton family and I would like to know if any of them are still around Wolverhampton.
