

'King of World' Visits Arkansas

FAYETTEVILLE—Close to home, some 2500 students at Fayetteville turned out to cheer the "King of the World." Bishop Homer Tomlinson, proclaiming "Everywhere I go I bring a miracle," spoke at the Greek amphitheater before his fans who chanted "We want a miracle" and "Whoo-pig-sooee."
