initely made Rice their first choice.

For the "many students who haven't decided between several schools, "multiple applications are still the answer," he said.

"The student has a longer period in which to choose his school."

Mr. Giles amended the statement that early decision candidates were required to meet the same standards as regular admissions candidates. Some latitude was allowed on SAT scores

for senior-year subjects that hadn't been taken by the candidates. "Otherwise, all requirements were the same."

The 121 successful applicants who accepted Rice's offer of admission each put up a deposit of \$100 on notice of their admissions.
