

Rice Alum Named As S. I. Nominee

James K. "Jim" Nance of Houston, Tex., has been nominated for the 1962 Sports Illustrated Silver Anniversary All-American Award by Rice University.

In the Cotton Bowl game 25 years ago, Nance faced another Silver Anniversary All-America nominee—Colorado's Associate U. S. Supreme Court Justice "Whizzer" White. Both were Phi Beta Kappa students and outstanding players.

A superior student as an undergraduate at Rice, then at the University of Texas law school, Mr. Nance saw extensive service as an officer in combat with the U. S. Navy in World War II. Returning to Houston in 1946, he has been a civic leader as well as a highly successful attorney.

Nance is now a partner in one of the nation's leading law firms—Baker, Botts, Shepherd, and Coates.
