| Comments | In 1911, at 16 stories, this was the tallest building in Houston until the 17-story Rice Hotel was completed in 1912. Very successful financially, causing addition of 6 more stories in 1928. Neoclassical exterior design, until white marble facing, completely covering the original exterior, was added in renovation in the 1960s or 1970s. Extant in 2007. |
