

# Danforth Fellows Sought Through Scholar Program

Rice seniors planning to do graduate work in any field in anticipation of a college teaching career who might be interested in the Danforth Graduate Fellowship program should contact Dean J. R. Sims.

The Danforth Foundation offers grants of up to \$1500 or more in some cases to approximately one hundred men preparing for college teaching in any recognized field who at the time of applying have had no graduate study. Danforth Fellowships may be used at any accredited university in the U.S.A.

Final selection of Fellowship Recipients will be made by Danforth officials on the basis of outstanding academic ability, personality congenial to the classroom, and integrity and character, including serious inquiry within the Christian tradition. (Non-Christians will be considered provided they are willing to participate in a predominately Christian program.)
