Bernhard Wins Marshall Award

Jim Bernhard, a senior history major, has been awarded a Marshall Scholarship grant to the University of Birmingham, England. He will work on an M.A. in English at the Honours School of English there.

Twelve of these two-year scholarships are awarded annually to outstanding American students, selected on a basis of intellect and character from different regions of the United States.

The scholarship covers tuition, transportation to and from the United Kingdom, and a living allowance while there.

Bernhard, a Phi Beta Kappa student, is president of the Rice Forensic Society and was editor of the Thresher last year.
