

Wiess Thefts Call For Court Action; Student Released

The Wiess College Court convicted and suspended a member of Wiess on March 30 for a series of petty thefts amounting to \$226.50.

The Court called for immediate suspension from Wiess College and Rice University until the spring semester of 1967.

The Court also demanded complete restitution to the persons who were robbed. The convicted student will return the money by April 15.
