

# A F Open For Officer Offers

The Air Force is inaugurating an Officer Training Program, which will begin in the fall of 1959 to expand its officer procurement programs. It will supplement the AFROTC program as a source of officers.

Applicants must be college graduates who have the skills, specialties and educational background needed by the Air Force to meet active duty requirements. They will undergo aptitude and

medical examinations before they are selected for officer training.

If selected, they will be required to complete successfully a precommission training course of three months at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas, and upon graduation will be commissioned as Second Lieutenants in the Air Force Reserve.
