

Transcendence scheduled topic of Holcomb talk

Dr. Harmon R. Holcomb, professor of philosophy of religion at Colgate Rochester Divinity School, is delivering this year's Rockwell Lecture on the general topic "The Language of Theology: Metaphor, Model, and Agent."

Tonight Holcomb will present the last lecture in the series. His topic is "The Language of Justification: Acts and Agents." He will speak at 8 pm in the Chapel.

In his first lecture, Tuesday, Holcombe departed somewhat from his announced topic to provide background about the "language of transcendence." He posited that transcendence underlies even the most ordinary activities. His thesis was that the modern-day of transcendence and a meaning for the word "God" were inevitable, given the model of knowledge in our time.
