
Crippled Children Get \$1544 Fund From Rice Drive

Several underprivileged crippled children in the Houston area have already taken advantage of the fund for leg braces, crutches and wheel chairs established at the Texas Institute for Rehabilitation and Research in the Medical Center with \$1,544.20 from the Rice Charity Drive this spring.

About half the sum came from student donations in classrooms, and the rest from contributions by the Student Senate, the colleges, the lites, and other campus organizations.

The Rice Charity Drive is conducted each spring under auspices of the Senior Class and is the only drive for which campus students are solicited.

Chairman of the 1960 drive was Nona Dale Snyder, with Mike Beldon as business manager.
