

# European Study Grant Offered

A \$1,750 scholarship for a year at the College of Europe is being offered by the American Committee on United Europe. The award will be made to a graduate of an American college with a background in social science. Candidates for the scholarship must be able to speak and write French, must be under 30 and single, have a US citizenship and a medical certificate.

The recipient of the scholarship will attend the 1959-60 ses-

sion of the College of Europe at Bruges, Belgium, where courses and seminars are given in International Economics, Public Administration, Economic Geography, European History, Political Theory, Sociology and Comparative, and Constitutional and International Law. A series of study trips is part of the curriculum. It has an enrollment of 40 students.

The scholarship includes transportation from New York to Bruges and return, tuition, board, and incidental expenses.
