

# May Paces Rice Victories At Penn; Owl Hurdlers Tie World Record

Bobby May helped the Rice track team to two first places in the Pen Relays last Saturday. May is undefeated this year in the 120 yard high hurdles. He won the Penn Relays with a 14.0.

May also anchored the 480-yard shuttle relay to a national collegiate record equalling time of 57.5. Verl Brown, who also reached the finals in the high hurdles, Gary Collins, and Jim Wilkerson were also on the relay team.

The Owls dropped the baton in both the 440 and 880 yard

relays. Unused to the narrow lanes at Franklin Field, they had the baton hit in exchanging by other runners.

The mile relay finished an unexpected fifth to Maryland State with a 3:13.9. The slow time was due to the poor condition of the "powdery, cutup track." The sprint medley team finished fourth to Kentucky State.

Warren Brattlof continued his fine spring performance by placing second to John Uelses. Brattlof vaulted 15'-0.
