

Jones, Baker lead in honor placement

Jones and Baker Colleges again led the other four residential colleges in last semester's honor roll.

Jones College had the greatest percentage of membership listed. They hit the 39% mark with 93 members on the roll.

Baker, the smallest of the men's colleges, had 110 members on the roll, the highest number of any of the colleges, and 31% of the membership.

Brown College, the smallest of all colleges, had 62 members or 29.2% of its membership listed. With 101 names listed, Wiess scored 26.6%; Will Rice followed close behind with 26.2%, or 99 members. Hanszen came in last, placing only 92 scholars, or 25.6% of its membership.
