

Civil Service Exams For Civil Scientists

More than 200 of the most inquisitive-minded college seniors and recent graduates in the country will be sought for Federal scientific research positions through an intensive, nationwide search, the Civil Service Commission announced today.

Mechanics of the search is a nation-wide, written civil service examination which will be given in February at more than 1,000 examination points across the nation. Qualified applicants may

file for the examination from December 1 through March 3.

"The college seniors or graduates who make the grade will be paid a starting salary of \$5,430 a year and can set their career sights on the highest-level research positions in the Federal Government, if they can measure up to the challenges of the research work and grow professionally in their positions," the Commission said. Only research positions will be filled through this examination.

The Laboratories are offering career research positions in the fields of engineering, chemistry, electronics, mathematics, metallurgy, and physics.
