

Frosh Absorb 34-6 Loss; Meet Del Mar

The Texas Yearlings stampeded over the Rice Owlets for five touchdowns and a 34-6 victory in a freshman game played in Austin last Friday. The game was the Texas freshmen's thirteenth straight without a defeat.

The Yearlings could do no wrong as they marched for three touchdowns on the ground and hit on scoring passes of 32 and 37 yards. They amassed 427 total yards, 325 on the ground as they scored at least once in every quarter.

Quarterback Duke Carlisle spearheaded the well balanced attack built around a number of fine running backs and a rugged defensive line. Carlisle scored one touchdown, passed for another and led all ball carriers with 54 yards rushing.

Rice's only score came on a 10-yard pass from Benny Hollingsworth to end Vic Anderson in the fourth quarter.

The Owlets return home this week still seeking their first victory of the season. Their Thursday night game with Del Mar Junior College is the first of three games scheduled in Rice Stadium this weekend.
