

Nielsen To Talk At Jewish Center On Japan's Faith

The impact of post-war religion in Japan upon western thought will be the subject of an address by Dr. Niels Nielsen, Rice Institute professor of Philosophy and Religion, Sunday evening, April 12, at 8 pm at the Jewish Community Center, 2020 Hermann Drive.

Dr. Nielsen, who recently returned from a year of advanced study in Europe, is expected to explain the changing relations between the United States and Japan resulting from the "new" religion of Japan. There will be a discussion following Dr. Nielsen's talk.

The lecture-forum, which will be open to the public, is sponsored by the Adult Activities Committee of the Jewish Community Center.
