

Casts Announced, Rehearsals Begin For 4 One Acts

"Don't run around in the Nude" is one of the one-act plays to be presented by the Players, March 1, 2, and 3. The play is by Georges Feydeau and was translated from the French for the Players by Mr. Don Tappan, Rice French instructor.

Phyllis Moore and Mike Holmes will direct Mike Cox, Ginny Sturgis, Fred Holt, Thom Scrutchin, and Clark Moore in this lively comedy.

THE SET of one-acts which has been expanded to include four plays instead of the customary three, also includes "Strange Road," "Hello, Out There," and an original as yet untitled play by John Taylor, Rice Assistant Professor of English.

"Strange Road," by John Houston, will be directed by James Anderson and has a cast of three: Dennis Kear, Ann Clark, and Rosalie Brown.

"Hello, Out There" was written by William Saroyan and will be directed by Chuck Yingling, who will also direct the Taylor play.
