

# History Society Schedules First Meeting Monday

A new undergraduate association known as The Rice History Society was founded at a special meeting of majors in the Department of History at Cohen House last Monday night.

The purpose of the new Rice History Society is to promote further interest in history and immediately related subjects among students in the department, as well as to promote closer contact between the faculty and the students in the department.

The new society, which will have a minimum of organization, currently plans to meet twice a month to hear speakers on various historical problems and to discuss historical questions informally.

The first meeting of the society is to be held this Monday evening at 8 o'clock at Cohen House, when the speaker will be Professor David Ogg, Honorary Fellow and Librarian of New College Oxford, who is visiting professor in the History Department here this year.

Professor Ogg, one of the great living authorities on seventeenth century history and author of a number of widely known books on the subject, will speak on "The Study of History at Oxford." Discussion and refreshments will follow.
