

# FRENCH UNIVERSITY HAS COURSES FOR U.S. STUDENTS

American undergraduates, plus a few graduate students, began courses this fall at the Institute for American Universities in Aix-en-Provence, on European history, languages, art, politics, international relations, sociology, and comparative education.

Besides offering classes in English in an American Curriculum to facilitate the transfer of credits; the cost of attending the Institute, including trans-Atlantic travel, equals the average at an American private college or university.

Starting in January 1959, the Institute will offer its "European

Semester Program" whereby students can study in Aix for one semester alone. The Summer Programs in French Civilization, European Modern Art, and European Music will be offered at the University's famous centers at Nice and Cannes on the Riviera.
