

Shepherd School Chooses Perkins For First Concert

Marion Perkins, described as "one of today's uniquely daring pianistic gifts" will open the Rice University concert season at 8:15 p.m., Thursday, October 24, in Hamman Auditorium.

The piano concert will be the first of seven performances to be offered by the Shepherd School of Music during the 1963-64 academic year. All performances are open to the general public without charge. Miss Perkins will play works by Bach, Beethoven, Mendelssohn, Brahms, Norman Dello Jois, and Chopin. She will introduce works of a new composer, Charles Garland.

Dr. Perkins will go from Houston to Mexico City where she is scheduled to play a concert October 29. Now a member of the music faculty at Colorado Women's College in Denver, she received her Ph.D. in musicology from the University of Southern California.
