

MIT Outscores Rice

Freshman and others who may be impressed by the SAT averages for the entire class might note that the MIT Class of '68, all 890 of them, averaged a rugged 760 in the SAT math and a 672 on the verbal test. The Chemistry-physics achievement average was 700.

The 890 included a slim 47 coeds, with 706 high schools represented from 49 states and 24 foreign countries. About 38% qualified for advanced standing at the Massachusetts school, reported the campus newspaper.
