

Students, Faculty To Hear Harvard's Noted Theologian

Professor Paul J. Tillich of Harvard University begins a series of lectures this morning, Tuesday, initiating Rice University's Religious Emphasis Week, 1961.

Having arrived yesterday afternoon, Dr. Tillich will be the guest of the University until Friday morning, when he will return to Harvard.

During R-E Week, he will deliver two lectures a day in Hamman Hall; however, only the evening lectures will be open to the general public. This should insure the Rice student's being able to get a seat for at least one of Dr. Tillich's lectures.

Author of such thought-provoking books as the *Courage To Be* and *The Dynamics of Faith*, Prof. Tillich will attempt to direct his remarks to the areas in which the students here have expressed interest, and not to abstractions which the average student might not have the background to understand. The Campus Store will also try to have

copies of these two books for sale.

Dr. Tillich will also have various opportunities to talk to Rice students informally on occasions such as at the Jones tea this afternoon and at meals in the different colleges.

It is hoped that all students will take advantage of this opportunity to hear one of the world's most renowned contemporary theologians.
