

Noted Conservative Speaks In Houston

William F. Buckley, Jr., author, editor, and lecturer, will speak Thursday, tomorrow, at 8:00 p.m. at the Music Hall. The talk, under the auspices of the Houston Jaycees, will deal with foreign affairs.

Buckley, whom Sen. Goldwater has called "the chief spokesman for the young conservative revival in this country," is editor of "National Review" magazine. He is author of "God and Man at Yale," "McCarthy and His Enemies," and "Up from Liberalism." He has recently debated Norman Thomas and Michael Harrington.
