

Hancock Directs, Players Present Brecht's 'Galileo'

Tickets for the Rice Players' production of Bertolt Brecht's "Galileo" are now on sale for \$1.00 in the Memorial Center.

Performances will be given from Thursday, December 6 thru Sunday, December 9 with matinees at 2:30 pm Saturday and Sunday, and evening performances Thursday, Friday and Saturday at 8:15 pm and Sunday at 7:30 pm.

DIRECTING the production will be New York director John Hancock, who has made a career of staging the works of Bertolt Brecht. A Harvard graduate, Mr. Hancock recently directed the production of Brecht's "A Man is a Man" in New York.

In the title role of Galileo will be Rice graduate Jim Bernhard, who is now assistant city editor of the Houston Press.

Several members of the faculty will also participate, including Dr. Hugh Duncan of the Sociology Department, Dr. Joseph I. Davies of the Biology Department, Mr. Jim Heath, Classics Instructor, and Dr. John E. Parrish of the English Department.
