

Wiess, Hanszen to vie for crown

The College Basketball Championship will be settled tonight at 6 p.m. as Hanszen and Wiess meet as a preliminary to the Rice-Texas Tech game.

Hanszen reached the finals via a 36-31 victory over pre-tourney favorite Baker. Baker's championship hopes were dealt a severe blow by baseball coach Doug Osborn's decision not to let baseball players participate.

Osborn's action, apparently calculated to improve relations between the Athletic Department and the colleges, eliminated Baker's high scorers Ronnie Henson and Andy Rooker. Lynn Morris of Hanszen was the game's leading scorer.

Wiess gained the other play-off spot with a 45-39 victory over Will Rice, as Bill Howard and Stuart Long led all scorers. In the consolation game played Tuesday, Baker defeated Will Rice.
