Semicentennial

With Panel Talk

The Fondren Library joined the ranks of university divisions presenting Semicentennial programs this Wednesday with a panel discussion entitled "Research Requirements and the Modern University Library."

PARTICIPANTS IN the discussion moderated by Librarian Hardin Craig, Jr., were William S. Dix, Librarian of Princeton University and former librarian of Fendren Library; Edward G. Holley, Director of Libraries at the University of Houston; Richard L. O'Keefe, Science Librarian at Rice; and Howard F. McGaw, Acting Librarian at Texas Southern University.

Each of the participants confined himself to one particular level of library science. Dr. Dix spoke on the national aspect, Dr. Holley on the regional aspect, Mr. O'Keefe on the local level, and Dr. McGaw on the personal level.

On Thursday, Dr. Dix again spoke in the Fondren Lecture Lounge, this time under the auspices of the Friends of the Fondren Library. The subject was the relationship between UNESCO and education.
