

Parkway Tutors Begin New Plan

The Parkway Tutoring project will be run on a more selective basis this semester, working with only 25 children who have been referred for help by the principals and teachers of their schools.

According to project chairman George Delevan only children in the third through sixth grades will be admitted. The immediate aim of the program is to give these children the academic background necessary for them to keep up in school.

Tutoring begins February 8 with sessions on Monday through Thursday from 7:15 to 8:15. Tutors meet at the Sallyport at 6:55 for rides to the Court.
