

Germanic Grants Offered At T. U.

Three National Defense Graduate Fellowships will provide for study in Germanic languages at the University of Texas.

The fellowships, beginning in 1959-60, may be for three years and are intended for students working toward the Doctor of Philosophy degree. The stipend is \$2,000 for the first year, \$2,000 for the second year and \$2,400 for the third year, plus \$400 each year for each dependent.

The fellowships, authorized by Congress through the National Defense Education Act of 1958, are primarily for persons preparing for careers in college teaching.

Application forms may be obtained from Dr. Leo Hughes, Fellowship Director, Graduate

School, University of Texas, Austin 12. Forms will be accepted until May 1, but should be received by March 1 for primary consideration.

Awards will be made to persons who have completed the baccalaureate degree or its equivalent. Applicants may not have completed more than a half-year of previous graduate work toward the doctoral degree.
