

# Women's College Split Announced

On Thursday, March 18, the division of the women students of Rice University, into two colleges was made.

In this division an attempt was made to keep the same number of members of each class in each college. There was also an attempt to keep on equal division between Houston, out-of-town, and out of state girls.

After the announcement of the college split, there was an appeals period lasting until 6 o'clock Friday. In that time a girl who was assigned to a college not of her choice was allowed to appeal for a change.

A sign of the relative successfulness of the split is that only eight girls appealed for a change of college. These appeals were granted.
