

# Plans Made For Sugar Bowl Party in French Quarter

At long last, final plans are set for Rice University's journey to the Sugar Bowl in New Orleans.

The location for the official Rice "Blast" will be the American Legion Hall—located at 334 Royal Street in the heart of the French Quarter. The time will be 9:00 to 1:00 am, on January 1, 1961, and music will be by Kid Williams' Dixieland Band. Tickets are currently going for \$2.75 per couple, with the stag price being \$1.50. Mixed drinks will go for sixty cents a shot.
