# Texaco Aid-To-Education Program Makes Unrestricted Gift To Rice

President Kenneth S. Pitzer has announced an unrestricted gift to Rice of \$50,000 from Texaco, Inc., as part of that firm's aid-to-education program for the 1962-63 academic year.

**THE GRANT** was in addition to the annual Texaco support of
