

Attendance Up At Open Houses In Wiess College

The Wiess open houses this fall, on September 25 and October 2, have been better attended than standard open houses in the past.

Wiess College President, Chuck King, reported an unprecedented number of guests. Seventeen young ladies attended the open house in September; 38 registered as guests on October 2. King estimated that the attendance figures exceeded former statistics by 75 to 100 percent.

Although the college visiting hours were from 12 to 7 pm, the majority of the girls viewed the rooms for a brief time. No trouble was encountered. The co-operation of college members was cited by King as a major factor in the success of open house at Wiess.

In looking to the future, King said he hopes that the college can soon be opened to guests on a regular basis. He also foresees increased informality in the observance of open house.
