
Band Appearing On TV At Bowl

The Rice Band, with an expected strength of eighty members, will leave Houston International Airport by commercial DC-7 airliners early January 1, 1961.

During the two days of Sugar Bowl festivities they plan to quarter at the new Hilton Inn, located near the Crescent City's airport.
