

Referendum Slated On Proposed Amendment For Inter-College Court

A referendum to rule on a proposed amendment to the constitution of the Inter-College Court will be held next Wednesday, January 12. The amendment (see text on page 6) would change the jurisdiction of the court to allow it to rule on cases of members of one college involved in offenses of all-school importance.

Jeff Paine, Chairman of the Inter-College Court, said that

he considered this amendment necessary to the court's fulfilling its role in the student judicial system. He pointed out that the amendment had been unanimously recommended by the chief justice of each individual college court.

Polls for the referendum will be open in the Anderson Hall cloister and the RMC from 9 till 1. A three-quarters majority of those voting is required to effect the change.
