Harold Downs, editor, Theatre and Stage. London, 1954. \$19.60 An encyclopaedic work.

Aage Bentzen, Introduction to the Old Testament. Copenhagen, 1952. \$11.94 Recommended by Professor Nielson.

On the following, we should like to publish the bans for the second time:

G. A. Buerger, The Chase, and William and Helen, Translated by Walter Scott. Edinburgh, 1796. \$17.25 Walter Scott's first published work, from the library of Dr. R. W. Chapman of Oxford. Dr. Chapman follows the excellent practice of preserving all significant correspondence about his books, and passes on such material when the book changes hands. Thus we acquire with this choice item two letters from the famous (indeed notorious) Thomas J. Wise, and one from a dealer, establishing the fact that the binding of this copy may be described as "contemporary boards." The only thing that would take us farther back than this would be "original wrappers." An extremely interesting acquisition at a very moderate price.

The following works are not here, but are desired and hoped for. The group of old titles with which this series begins have already been spotted in dealers' catalogues and ordered, because opportunity in these cases knocks if not just once at most at infrequent intervals.

Vanbrugh and Cibber, *The Provok'd Husband*. London, 1728. First edition. \$4.20

James Bentham, *History and Antiquities of the Conventual Cathedral Church of Ely*. 1812-17. \$16.80 Profusely illustrated.

William Beckford, *Italy*. 1834. \$7.00 -- We are accumulating a nice little group of works by and about Beckford, a remarkable minor genius in whom people are getting interested.

Samuel Pordage, *The Siege of Babylon*. London, 1678. \$8.82 One of the hard-to-get Restoration dramatists.

D. Blum, *A Pictorial History of the Silent Screen*. \$7.00 Based on a large collection of photographs, many of them unique.

H. M. Colvin, *A Biographical Dictionary of English Architects, 1660-1840*. \$9.00
