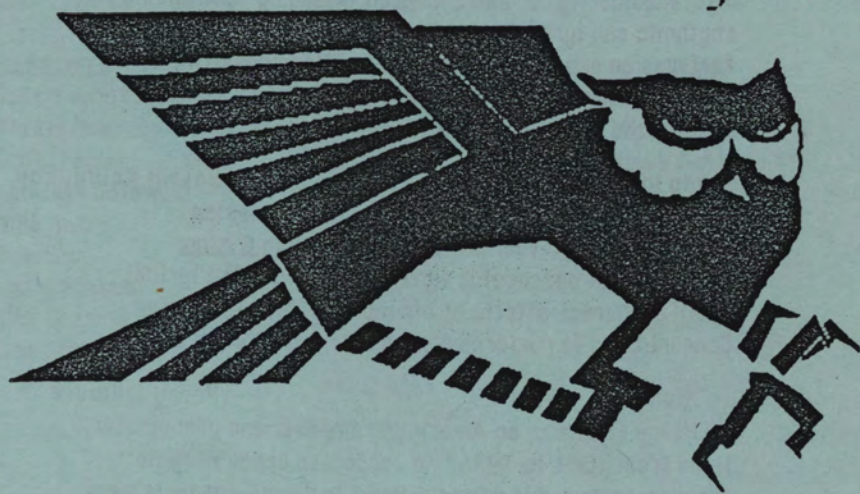

## Rice University Concert Band\*

### **Folk Song Suite**

**Vaughan Williams**

English composer Ralph Vaughan Williams lived from 1872 to 1958. Although his works ranged from operas and symphonies to a tube concerto, he was fascinated by the folk music of his native country. Folk Song Suite was composed for military band in 1924.

### **March to the Scaffold**

**Hector Berlioz**

Hector Berlioz was a French composer who lived from 1803 to 1869. In his compositions he tried to escape the constraints of the classical form, and he became a leading romantic composer. His Symphonie fantastique, from which March to the Scaffold is taken, describes the opium dream of a lovesick musician.

### **Incantation and Dance**

**John Barnes Chance**

John Barnes Chance, a modern American composer, wrote primarily for band. Characterized by contrasting rhythmic and lyrical sections, Incantation and Dance features an expanded percussion section consisting of Maracas, Claves, Timbals, Gourd, Tambourine, Temple Blocks, and Timpani.

### **Symphony in G Minor**

**Vassili Kalinnikov**

Vassili Kalinnikov (1886-1901) was a Russian composer and bassoonist. His Symphony in G Minor was his most successful work, and displays the lyrical quality characteristic of his music. This setting for Concert Band is performed with antiphonal brass choirs.

### **Rolling Thunder**

**Henry Fillmore**

Henry Fillmore, an American composer and bandmaster, lived from 1881 to 1956. He conducted bands in radio broadcasts and in the Orange Bowl in Miami, but he is best known for his popular marches. Rolling Thunder is a circus march, and is used to accompany the elephant act.
