THE CONDUCTOR

Dr. Ken Dye, director of bands at Rice University, is a graduate of the University of Houston, where he holds a Doctorate in Music Education and a Master's in Business Administration. He also has earned the degrees of Master of Arts in Music from California State University and Bachelor of Music in trombone performance from the University of Southern California. At Rice University, he is the director of the Marching Owl Band, the Concert Band and the Jazz Ensemble. He has conducted the Houston Concert Band since 1984. Dr. Dye was the producer/director of the opening ceremonies for the U.S. Olympic Festival held in Houston in 1986; directed the All-American College Band at the 50th Presidential Inauguration in Washington, D.C.; directed the Olympic All-American Marching Band for the opening and closing ceremonies of the 1984 Summer Games in Los Angeles; directed the band for the Statue of Liberty celebration closing ceremonies in 1986; and for several years, directed the half-time activities for the Bluebonnet Bowl. He has written over 400 musical arrangements for band and has also served as director of the All-American College Band at DisneyWorld in Orlando, Florida. Dr. Dye is currently organizing shows and arranging music for the half-time activities at five college bowl games which will occur at the end of this year.
