BRIAN KAUK is the principal trombonist of the Houston Grand Opera Orchestra, and the second trombonist of the Houston Ballet Orchestra. He performs frequently with the Houston Symphony and is an active free-lance musician performing with many commercial groups.

Mr. Kauk has recently performed with the Austin Lyric Opera, the San Antonio Symphony, and the Grand Teton Festival Orchestra. His major teachers have been Albert Lube, Allen Barnhill, and David Waters.

RAE SHANNON received her Master of Music degree from Mississippi College. She was the principal keyboardist with the Mississippi Symphony from 1976 to 1992. Since moving to Houston in 1992, she has performed many recitals with woodwinds, brass, and voice. Currently, she is a piano instructor at San Jacinto College and assistant organist at the Episcopal Church of St. John the Divine.
