She is a student of Kenneth Goldsmith, and her previous teachers include Pamela Klingensmith and Si-Yang Lao. She has participated in many summer camps, including Killington Music Festival, SMU-in-Taos, and ENCORE School for Strings, where she studied with Victor Danchenko. Last year Chaerim won the Southwest Region of the MTNA High School Concerto Competition and performed Bruch's **Scottish Fantasy** with the Waco Symphony Orchestra.*
